Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Christmas is here! In these 12 days, we celebrate the remembrance of the birth of Jesus Christ. In that Holy birth through the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Word of God became flesh. Through that incarnation of God, our Lord dwelt among us and labored to redeem all who would but believe so they may be brought back to the Father. The celebration of Christmas, however, is not just a birthday party. Christmas is not just remembering the beginning of the story of salvation.

Christmas is the beginning of a real and personal relationship with God , and with all of humanity. Through the Incarnation, God came among us through the birth of Jesus Christ. Christmas is a time of joy in which we praise God for the gift of His Son, Jesus Christ. It is also a yearly reminder that with His birth came His ministry, death, resurrection, and ascension. At Christmas, we should seek to grow in the relationship that began with His birth. We are invited to grow into deeper relationships with Jesus at the celebration of His birth. It is a reminder that a God who loves us gave us Jesus so that we have a chance at that relationship. Through that relationship the primary purpose of Jesus' birth is fulfilled. Jesus was born not just to heal the divide our sin created between the Father and us. It is through the birth of Jesus we can find spiritual and physical healing. It is through His birth that we are given our great physician. It is with Jesus that we are given the healing that only He can give. At Christmas, the brokenness of the world and the pain of Sin can be redeemed.

As we celebrate these twelve days of Christmas, let us not just let them pass us by. Let us not just think of ourselves in these twelve days. Let us, in our joy, focus on the source of that joy, Jesus Christ. Let us, in gratefulness, use these twelve days as a celebration of His birth and our relationship with Him. Let us grow deeper in that relationship so

we may honor the gift God gave us in the birth of His only Son, who lived and died and was resurrected so He may continue to dwell with us.


