With the first week of April rapidly approaching, we will be entering into Holy Week. We will, as a parish, have plenty of opportunities to come together to learn, worship, and pray together beginning with Eucharist on Palm Sunday.


While all the days of Holy Week are filled with significance and time for reflection and prayer focusing on the passion of our Lord Jesus Christ, the primary communal aspect of Holy Week is the **Paschal Triduum:** Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday. To those outside of a liturgical tradition, these days and services can have little or no meaning. However, within our tradition, the liturgies are filled with meaning and tradition. These three services, I believe, are just as essential to a Christian's spiritual life as Easter is.


At one of the Lenten suppers, Fr. David Wyly of St. Stephens shared a story from an article that he had read. The article associated participation in the Triduum with that of attending a symphony. You can go to any one of the parts, and it is a wonderful and beautiful experience. Yet, if you leave after just one act, you will miss the rest of the story and the intended result of the symphony.

The Triduum is like this in that you can attend any of the services on their own, and if you allow it, it will be a powerful moment. However, to fully understand the Triddum and to allow it to prepare you for the full glory of Easter, it must be done with intentional attendance to the whole Triduum. I invite and pray that you will attend all three services within the Triduum. I also pray that whatever you do, it will be to understand better the gravity of Christ's passion and the glory that occurs on Easter day.


