My name is Ethan Stroud, but everyone calls me Whit as it is a family name. I am from Washington, North Carolina, a small town in Eastern NC sitting on both the Tar and Pamlico rivers, a short boat ride from the Pamlico Sound. I am a postulant of the Diocese of East Carolina for Holy Orders to the Priesthood and a 3rd-year student at Sewanee. Before my time in Sewanee, I graduated from East Carolina University with a bachelor's in history specializing in Tudor England and a bachelor's in Religious Studies focusing on New Testament studies. I am a cradle Episcopalian, always being a member at my sending parish of St. Peter's, which was a 3-minute walk across the street from my house. I could see it from my bedroom window every day. However, due to my mother and grand-parents, I have also spent a lot of time in other denominations, primarily the Methodist and FWB church. I also volunteered in children and youth ministries at St. Peter's. When the director retired, I was hired and served as Director of Children and Youth ministries during my gap year while also working full-time pressure washing.

On a lighter note, things that I reckon would be my hobbies and interests: I am a major history buff on pretty much anything, but currently, I've been reading on the history of the Outer Banks of NC, specifically as a haven for pirates. Duck hunting and fishing also eat up a lot of my time. Hors-

es have also been a major part of my life. In high school, I competed in Ranch Sortings; while in undergrad, I rode for the club team in Hunt-Seat as a point rider for most of my collegiate career. Horses helped me land a job for three summers as a riding instructor at a large Y camp on the coast, where I also worked at the fishing station.

I also want to thank y'all for allowing me to work and continue to learn and am excited to see what God has planned going forward.

Please convey our love and best wishes to Bill Hayes, the choir, and other members of the congregation that we always consider our NC family. I pray that you stay safe and well.









