Dear St. Francis Family,

When I think about this past year of our life together as a parish, I can only sum it up as "we have been busy!" We should be happy when people say, "Oh, wow, y'all are doing a lot!" I'm grateful for the opportunity for us to do "a lot," and we're always looking for more.

For us to come together as a community of worshippers in these beautiful buildings and grounds is a blessing. Participating in the Eucharist almost every Sunday is a huge privilege and blessing. Learning more about God through His word and Sacraments as a community is another blessing.

As a parish, St. Francis lives in a state of grace for all we can do. We are called to view what we do not as work or duty or tasks to check off on a list but as a privilege and an honor. The work, worship, and study we do all come from God. We are members of the Body of Christ, His church, His body. With our flaws and faults, we who struggle with sin are allowed by the Christ who forgives us to serve as His hands and feet in the world. We, freed from the fear of eternal death and the loneliness of sin, are called to proclaim the Gospel that releases us and take it to those whom we meet. We who have gained life, freedom, and peace from Jesus Christ are called to give these gifts to others. And we don't have to do it alone because we are a community.

Look at what we have built in just over a year: new people attending services, others returning to St. Francis, and our engagement with the other parishes in Goldsboro. Participating in these ministries, however, takes sacrifice, time, and effort. It takes money to keep our parish a thriving center of worship and learning. The sad reality is that the number of people able to do the work and the financial resources are dwindling while the need for outreach and for the sharing of the Gospel have grown.

Having me as priest-in-charge is part of that cost. We are operating at a deficit, and if we do not receive Diocesan funding to support my salary, we will be operating at an even greater deficit. What each of you is called to give financially is between you and God. Countless Scriptural references show that giving time and money is essential to living into our Christian vocation.

Our membership consists of 40 active participants, 23 of which pledged in 2023. We must have each member engaged in the life and ministry of this parish and its service to the Gospel of Jesus Christ and each member pledging financial support to secure our future.

When we work for Christ, we work in the field of hope and faith. We know that when we live faithfully to the mission of the Gospel in this parish, we serve the living Christ.






ADVENT FORMATION SERIES, 2023


