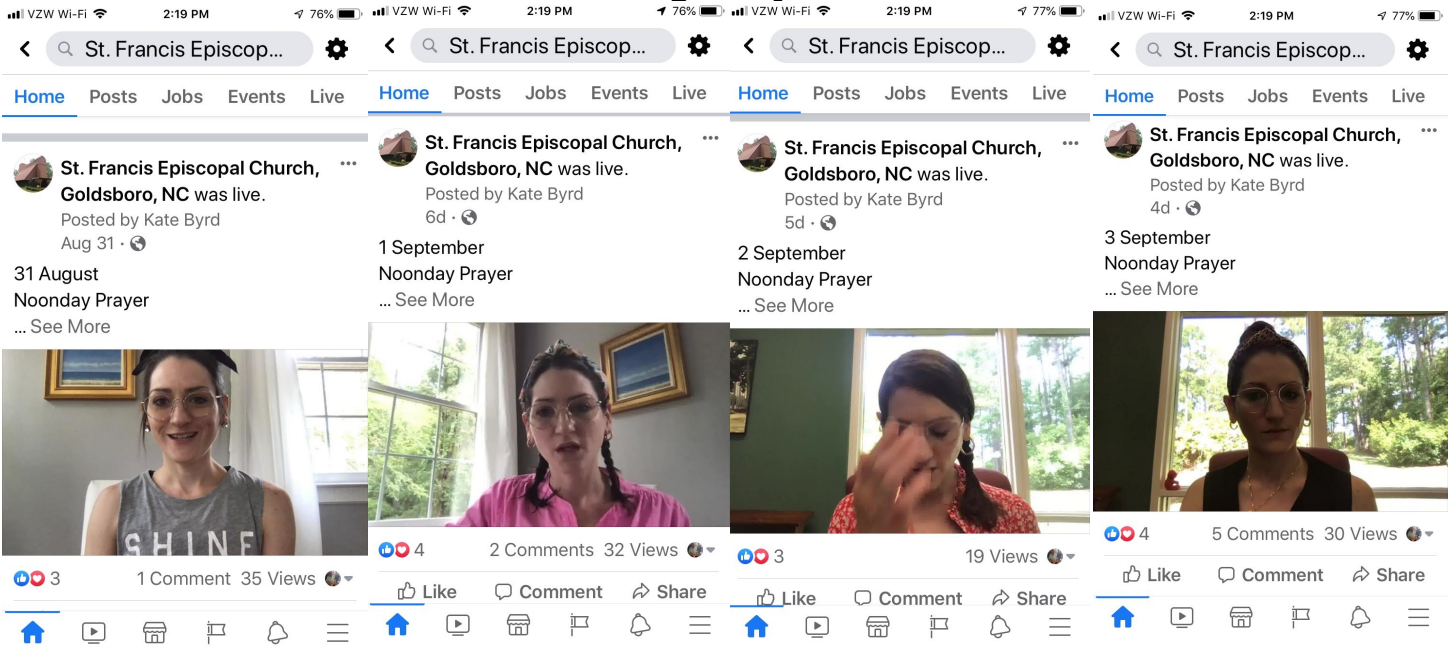
(keeping in touch during social distancing)
